Agenda 21 implementation is being accomplished through International Council of Local Environmental Initiatives (ICLEI) at local levels.


In the United States, the National Coordinating Body is the President's Council on Sustainable Development (PCSD).


Federal agencies have now adopted a "consensus" process to by-pass Congress and other elected bodies, to build consensus on Agenda 21 activities at local, state, and national levels.

1992

Agenda for the 21st Century was signed by 179 nations at the UN Conference on Environment and Development in Rio de Janeiro

Among other things, it called for a Global Biodiversity Assessment of the state of the planet. Prepared by the UN Environmental Program (UNEP), this GBA armed UN leaders with the "information" and "science" they needed to validate their global management system.

Its doomsday predictions were designed to excuse radical population reduction, oppressive lifestyle regulations, and a coercive return to earth-centered religions as the basis for environmental values and self-sustaining human settlements.

The root causes of the loss of biodiversity are embedded in the way societies use resources. It is a world view that is characterized by the denial of sacred attributes in nature, a characteristic that became firmly established about 2000 years ago with the Judeo-Christian/Islamic religious traditions.



HR 353 – 1992, HJ RES 166 - 1993

Chief sponsor of the resolution, **Nancy Pelosi**

A national strategy, based on countrywide consultations with a broad diversity of interests, and with efforts to engage all sectors, and levels in the process.

Research on sustainable consumption and production patterns, creation of an appropriate policy framework, and a strategy to cut subsidies which promote degradation of the resource base.

A Presidential plan for formulation of domestic and foreign policies, including foreign aid, and coordinating U.S. policy to implement Agenda 21

Agenda 21 for the United States

HR 353 – 1992, HJ RES 166 – 1993

The United States should adopt a national strategy for environmentally sustainable development, based on an extensive process of nationwide consultations with all interested organizations and individuals, including State and local governments, nongovernmental organization, businesses, and labor groups.

The United States Government should encourage and facilitate, at all levels of community and sectors of society, appropriate means for adopting individual Agenda 21 plans of action, including the establishment of local, county, State, business, and other boards and commissions for achieving sustainable development. Each member of the Congress should help initiate this process within their States or districts.

The President should establish an effective mechanism to plan, initiate, and coordinate United States policy for implementing Agenda 21 . Responsibility should be vested in a duly constituted office, headed by an appropriate high level official, and the necessary staff support structure should be provided.

Policies should be formulated for foreign policy and foreign assistance in order to help developing countries, and for domestic actions in order to assure appropriate action by the United States to implement Agenda 21

HR 353 – August 1992, HJ RES 166 – March 1993

The Congress should adopt a plan to reallocate an appropriate amount of savings from reduced defense spending in order to achieve its goals of global environmental protection and sustainable development over the next decade

In order to contribute to a transition to a sustainable United States economy, the research and policy initiatives urged in Agenda 21 should be pursued

Research on sustainable consumption and production patterns

Creation of a policy framework for sustainable consumption patterns, identification of a strategy to eliminate or reduce subsidies for unsustainable natural resource exploitation

Improve pricing policies;

Presidents Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD)

The role of the United States, as a major economic force and a country that has long been in the forefront of environmental protection activities nationally and internationally, should be one of leadership and positive action in the implementation process of Agenda 21 and all decisions of UNCED

Agenda 21 urges all governments to adopt national strategies for sustainable development, 'make significant progress' in incorporating environmental costs into economic decisions;

Undertake research for sustainable production methods, consumption patterns, other actions to make their economies more environmentally sustainable;

Agenda 21 calls for a supportive international climate for achieving environment and development goals

Providing adequate financial resources to developing countries and dealing with international debt

The reallocation of resources presently committed to military purposes to support United States policies

Selling Agenda 21

Achieving that consensus meant painting scary scenarios of a hurting, dying planet that frighten children, anger youth, and persuade adults to submit to the unthinkable regulations.

It means blaming climate change on human activities and ignoring the natural factors that have - throughout time - brought cyclical changes in climate, storm patterns, wildlife migration, and ozone thinning (there has never been a "hole")

Agenda 21 for the United States

In the US, federal agencies offer grants to local government bodies and NGOs to set up these stakeholder groups, usually set-up under the guise of soliciting input from the community.

The guide calls for the transforming of towns and cities into “sustainable communities” operating within the blueprint set out in Agenda 21. This is achieved by forming stakeholder or “visioning” councils, which are formed by government agencies. Whoever initiates the group will select individuals to take part. Stakeholders select a mixture of those who currently have no stake in the community and may gain influence in a transformed “sustainable” community, and others such as the media and business leaders who can be expected to promote the initiatives that derive from Agenda 21.

Stakeholders

Those involved are likely to be unaware that they're taking part in a UN agenda. The outcome of the group is pre-determined according the recommendations set out in Agenda 21, and the group will be led towards the desired outcome by having a trained facilitator chair the meetings, who will work to lead everyone to the right consensus, usually by marginalizing any opposition, usurping the democratic process.

Contact your state representatives and senators and make them aware of Agenda 21 and that you demand they do whatever necessary to keep state agencies from accepting grants or help from federal agencies.
